First Ballot Counting Update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **112,114** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote Center ballots and Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **1,249,137**, which is **22.66%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the [Official Election Canvass](#) period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **573,750**. This estimate does not include Vote by Mail ballots that were dropped at Vote Centers or Drop Box locations on Election Day.

- **Conditional Voter Registration:** 50,000
- **Provisional ballots:** 26,500
- **Vote by Mail ballots*:** 327,250
- **Misc. ballots**:** 170,000
