Fourth Election Results Update for the Statewide Direct Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the fourth ballot counting update for the Statewide Direct Primary Election.

The update includes **39,993** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **1,278,820**, which is **24.88%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted:

- **Provisional ballots***: 122,700
- **Vote by Mail ballots****: 100,000

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the [Official Election Canvass](#) period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
