OCT. 1 (Tu) E-49	OCT. 7 (M) E-43 5:00 P.M.	<p>PUBLIC EXAMINATION PERIOD FOR CANDIDATE STATEMENTS/CANDIDATE NAMES AND BALLOT DESIGNATIONS</p> <p>During this period, candidate statements shall be open for public examination. A fee may be charged to any person obtaining a copy of the material. During this period any person may file a writ of mandate or an injunction to require any or all of the data/material to be amended or deleted. For candidate names and ballot designations, a writ may be filed pursuant to E. C. §§ 13313 and 13314.</p>
OCT. 1 (Tu) E-49		<p>CERTIFIED LIST OF CANDIDATES</p> <p>Last day for the Secretary of State to send the certified list of candidates to county elections official.</p>
OCT. 10 (Th) E-40	OCT. 29 (Tu) E-21	<p>MAILING OF SAMPLE BALLOT</p> <p>A sample ballot booklet shall be mailed to each voter in the district during this period. (E. C. § 13303)</p>
OCT. 21 (M) E-29	NOV. 12 (Tu) E-7	<p>VOTE BY MAIL – FIRST AND LAST DAY TO APPLY</p> <p>Applications may be filed between these dates (both dates inclusive). Applications received prior to the 25th day preceding the election will be kept and processed during this period. (E. C. §§ 3001, 3102(e) and 10704)</p>
OCT. 21 (M) E-29		<p>POLLWORKERS AND POLLING PLACES – APPOINTMENT</p> <p>Last day to appoint pollworkers and designate polling places. A notice of appointment shall be mailed to each pollworker appointed. (E. C. §§ 12286, 12307 and 12319)</p>

NOV. 4 (M) E-15	CLOSE OF REGISTRATION Last day to register or transfer to vote in the election. (E. C. § 2102 and 2107)
NOV. 5 (Tu) E-14	BILINGUAL PRECINCT OFFICER LIST Last day to prepare list of appointed bilingual precinct officers. (E. C. § 12303(d))
NOV. 9 (Sa) E-10	CENTRAL TALLY LOCATION PUBLICATION Not later than this date a notice specifying the public place to be used as the tally center for counting the ballots shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the district. (E. C. § 12109 and Govt. § 6061)
NOV. 12 (Tu) E-7 5:00 P.M.	POLLING PLACE PUBLICATION Not later than this date, a list of polling places for each precinct shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the district. (E. C. § 12105, 12106 and Govt. Code § 6061) CANVASS OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS The canvass may commence on the 7 th day before the election, but the results of the tally shall not be released until after the polls close. (E. C. § 15101(b)) COMPUTER PROGRAM TO SECRETARY OF STATE Last day to send copy of computer vote counting program and Certificate of Logic and Accuracy Test to Secretary of State. (E. C. § 15001)
NOV. 13 (W) E-6 NOV. 19 (Tu) ELECTION DAY	EMERGENCY VOTE BY MAIL VOTING Between these dates, any voter may apply for a Vote By Mail ballot if conditions require his or her absence from the precinct on election day. The voter may designate an authorized representative to pick up and return the ballot. (E. C. §§ 3021 and 3110)

VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS RETURNED – 8:00 P.M.

Last day for Vote By Mail ballots to be received or turned in personally by the voter at any polling place in the jurisdiction. An authorized representative may return the voted ballot under specified conditions.
