L.A. County Voters Need to Register to Vote by May 23rd For the June 7, 2016 Presidential Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible Los Angeles County voters that the deadline to register to vote in the upcoming election is Monday, May 23rd at 11:59 p.m.

As of today, there are a total of 4.8 million registered voters and 1.7 million registered Vote by Mail voters in Los Angeles County.

Registering to vote is quick and easy. You can:

- Apply online at lavote.net.
- Mail a voter registration form, which is available at libraries, post offices and most government buildings. If you are unable to mail your form, drop it off at 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA.
- Verify your voter registration status by going to lavote.net.
