MAR. 29 (M) E-113		<p><b>NOTICE OF ELECTION — PUBLICATION</b></p> <p>On or before this date a notice of election shall be published. (E. C. § 12101 and Govt. Code § 6061)</p>
MAR. 30 (Tu) E-112*	APR. 23 (F) E-88 5:00 P.M.	<p><b>NOMINATION PERIOD</b></p> <p>First and last day for candidates to file nomination documents. (E. C. §§ 10220, 10224 and 10407)</p> <p><b>CANDIDATE STATEMENTS (WHERE APPLICABLE)</b></p> <p>During this period candidates may file a candidate statement not to exceed the word limitation (<b>200 or 400 words</b>) for inclusion in the Official Sample Ballot Booklet. The statement shall be filed no later than the last day to file nomination documents. (E. C. § 13307)</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> Candidate statements are <b>only</b> included in the Official Sample Ballot Booklet and <b>will not</b> be included in the Vote By Mail packet.</p>
APR. 23 (F) E-88		<p><b>NOMINATION DOCUMENTS — DEADLINE DATE</b></p> <p>Last day for candidates to file nomination documents. (E. C. §§ 10220, 10224 and 10407)</p> <p><b>CANDIDATE WITHDRAWAL</b></p> <p>No candidate whose Declaration of Candidacy has been filed may withdraw after this date. (E. C. § 10224)</p>

<b>APR. 24** (Sa)</b> E-87**	<b>MAY 03 (M)</b> E-78	<p><b>PUBLIC EXAMINATION PERIOD</b></p> <p>Recommended period to make available candidate statements, candidate names and ballot designations for public examination. A fee may be charged to any person obtaining a copy of the material. During this period any person may file a writ of mandate or an injunction to require any or all of the data/material in a candidate statement to be amended or deleted. (E. C. § 13313)</p> <p>For candidate names and ballot designations, a writ of mandate may be filed pursuant to E.C. § 13314.</p>
<b>APR. 29 (Th)</b> E-82 <b>11:00 A.M.</b>		<p><b>RANDOMIZED ALPHABET DRAWING</b></p> <p>The Secretary of State shall hold a public drawing to determine the order of candidate names to appear on the ballot by randomly drawing each letter of the alphabet. (E. C. § 13112)</p>
<b>MAY 24 (M)</b> E-57	<b>JULY 6 (Tu)</b> E-14	<p><b>STATEMENT OF WRITE-IN CANDIDACY</b></p> <p>A name written on a ballot will not be counted unless the person has filed during this period a Statement of Write-In Candidacy and sponsor signatures stating that he or she is a write-in candidate for the election. (E. C. §§ 8600, 8601 and 10103)</p>
<b>JUNE 21 (M)</b> E-29		<p><b>PRECINCT BOARD MEMBER AND VOTE CENTERS — APPOINTMENT</b></p> <p>Last day to appoint precinct boards and designate vote centers. A notice of appointment shall be mailed to each precinct officer. (E. C. §§ 12286, 12307 and 12319)</p> <p><b>MAILING OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</b></p> <p>No later than 29 days before the day of the election, the county elections official shall begin mailing the materials required by Section 3010. (E. C. § 3001(b), 3010 and 3206)</p>
<b>JUNE 29 (Tu)</b> E-21		<p><b>MAILING OF OFFICIAL SAMPLE BALLOT BOOKLETS (Historically commencing at E – 40)</b></p> <p>An Official Sample Ballot Booklet shall be mailed to each voter in the jurisdiction no later than 21 days before the election. (E. C. § 13303)</p>

\*April 24, May 1 and 8 (Saturdays) and April 25 and May 2 (Sundays) - RRCC office will be closed.

\*\*May 1 and 8 (Saturdays) and May 2 and 9 (Sundays) - RR/CC office will be closed

<b>JULY 6 (Tu)</b> E-14*		<p><b>CLOSE OF REGISTRATION</b> Last day to transfer or register to vote in the election. (E. C. §§ 2102 and 2107)</p> <p><b>PROCESSING VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</b> The full processing of vote by mail ballots may commence on the <b>10<sup>th</sup></b> business day before the election but the results of the tally shall not be released until after the polls close. (E. C. § 15101(b))</p>
<b>JULY 6 (Tu)</b> E-14	<b>JULY 20 (Tu)</b> ELECTION DAY	<p><b>NEW CITIZEN ELIGIBILITY TO REGISTER AND VOTE</b> A new citizen is eligible to register and vote at the office of, or at another location designated by, the county elections official at any time beginning on the 14th day before an election and ending at the close of polls on the election day following the date on which that person became a citizen. (E.C. § 3500)</p>
<b>JULY 6 (Tu)</b> E-14		<p><b>STATEMENT OF WRITE-IN CANDIDACY DEADLINE</b> Last day for a candidate to file sponsor signatures and a declaration stating that he or she is a write-in candidate in the election. (E. C. §§ 8600 and 8601)</p> <p><b>BILINGUAL PRECINCT BOARD MEMBER LIST</b> Last day to prepare list of appointed bilingual precinct board members. (E. C. § 12303)</p>
<b>JULY 8 (Th)</b> E-12		<p><b>WRITE-IN CANDIDATES — SUBMIT TO COUNTY</b> In the case of cities, <b>recommended</b> last day for the City Clerk to deliver the list of qualified write-in candidates to county elections official.</p>
<b>JULY 10 (Sa)</b> E-10*		<p><b>TALLY CENTER LOCATION — PUBLICATION</b> On or before this date a notice specifying the public place to be used as the central tally location for counting the ballots shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the jurisdiction. (E. C. § 12109)</p>

**JULY 20 (Tu)**ELECTION  
DAY**EMERGENCY VOTE BY MAIL**

Between these dates any voter may apply for a Vote By Mail ballot if conditions require his or her absence from the precinct on election day. The voter may designate an authorized representative to pick up and return the ballot.  
(E. C. §§ 3021 and 3110)

Polls open 7:00 a.m., close 8:00 p.m.

**VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS RETURNED — 8:00 P.M.**

Last day for Vote By Mail ballots to be received or turned in personally by the voter. An authorized representative may return the voted ballot under specified conditions.  
(E. C. §§ 3017 and 3020)

Any Vote By Mail ballot cast under this division shall be timely cast if it is received by the voter's elections official via the United States Postal Service or a bona fide private mail delivery company no later than three days after election day in addition to the provisions set forth in E. C. 3020, Sections 1 and 2.

(E. C. § 3020(b) Section 1 and 2)

**OFFICIAL CANVASS**

The canvass of election returns shall commence no later than the first Thursday following the election.  
(E. C. §§ 10262 and 15301)

**AUG. 19 (Th)**

**COMPLETION OF OFFICIAL CANVASS**

The county elections official shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to each jurisdiction within 30 days of the election.  
(E. C. § 15372)

**NOTE:** On **August 2, 2021** the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is tentatively scheduled to certify the election results. On **August 10, 2021** the Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election officially concluded.
