#### Last Day to Request a Vote by Mail Ballot for the March 5 General Law and Charter City Elections

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible voters in Los Angeles County that **Tuesday, February 26 at 11:59PM** is the deadline to request a Vote by Mail (VBM) ballot.

As of today, the RR/CC has issued **272,570** Vote by Mail ballots. Voters can request a Vote by Mail ballot by:

- Applying online at [lavote.net](http://lavote.net)
- Returning the VBM application on the back of the Sample Ballot
