Polls Closed and First Ballot Count for Special Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the closing of the polls for today's Special Elections in Assembly Districts 39, 45 and 54.

The first Election Night ballot count includes **40,565** returned Vote by Mail ballots out of **346,370** Vote by Mail ballots issued to the three districts.

Updates to the tally will be made throughout the evening as ballots arrive from all **593** polling places to Norwalk Headquarters for central tabulation.
