Seventh Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the California Gubernatorial Recall Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the seventh post-election ballot count update for the California Gubernatorial Recall Election.

The update includes **2,471** ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **2,941,120**, which is **51.69%** of registered voters. Election results can be viewed on [LAVote.net](#).

The estimated number of outstanding ballots to be processed is **18,900**. See estimates below:

- Vote by Mail ballots: 16,000
- Conditional Voter Registration ballots: 2,800
- Provisional ballots*: 100

The majority of remaining Vote by Mail ballots are those that are pending signature cure responses from voters whose signature on the Return Envelope is missing or did not match their registration record. These voters have been notified with instructions on how to cure their ballot.

All outstanding ballots are verified before being tallied. These numbers will adjust throughout the [Official Election Canvass](#) as we process and tally ballots.

The RR/CC is scheduled to certify election results on Thursday, October 14.
