### First Election Results Update for the Assembly District 51 Special Primary Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Assembly District 51 Special Primary Election.

The update includes **4584** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **21,894**, which is **9.91%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.
