Summary	Alternate Residency Confirmation (ARC)
Description	The system selects voters who have not voted in elections you select, or have not had any transactions after a date you specify, and imports them all into a single category. Although the option is titled "Failure to Vote", this feature really encompasses the failure to have different types of activity, one of which is voting. You then print notification cards from Import Reports and mail them to those voters. Process any responses you receive along with undelivered returned notifications. You choose when to apply the file back to the voter file to change the status of the voters to inactive.
