Certified Election Results for the June 7, 2016 Presidential Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced certified election results for the June 7th Presidential Primary Election.

A total of **2,026,068** ballots were processed and counted, with **42.13%** of eligible registered L.A. County voters casting ballots. For specific tallies, visit lavote.net.

On July 5th, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to declare the election results official.

The official election canvass period began on June 9th. During the official canvass, all outstanding ballots were processed, verified and tallied. The RR/CC also conducted a one-percent manual audit.
