#### Second Ballot Counting Update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **45,473** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **1,294,610**, which is **23.48%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the [Official Election Canvass](#) period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **802,380**. This estimate now includes Vote by Mail ballots that were dropped at Vote Centers or Drop Box locations on Election Day.

- **Conditional Voter Registration**: 50,000
- **Provisional ballots**: 26,500
- **Vote by Mail ballots\***: 555,880
- **Misc. ballots\*\***: 170,000
