**GENERAL ELECTION – NOVEMBER 2, 2010**

If the Superior Court office did not appear on the Statewide Direct Primary Election ballot, a write-in petition containing signatures of **100** registered voters qualified to vote for the office must be filed in order to place the office on the General Election ballot. The last day to file the petition with the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is August 11, 2010.
