What positions are available to me as a County Employee Pollworker?

Inspector:

Responsible for overall operation of polling place on Election Day. Must complete mandatory in-person and online training sessions and pick up/drop off Election Day supplies.

Stipend: **\$240** (Stipend breakdown: \$150 plus \$40 for completing mandatory training plus \$50 for picking up/dropping off materials). *Must be a U.S. Citizen and prior Pollworker experience preferred.*

NVC Director:

Oversee the NVC and direct voters to correct Official Table at polling places with more than one precinct.

Stipend: **\$140** (Stipend breakdown: \$100 plus \$40 for attending in-person training). *Must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident of United States.*

Clerk:

Helps with set-up and breakdown of polling place and assists voters. Inspector may request that a Clerk accompany him/her when dropping-off materials.

Stipend: **\$140** (Stipend breakdown: \$100 plus \$40 for attending in-person training). *Must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident of United States.*

What else do I need to know about the County Employee Pollworker Program?

Daily Pay:

County Pollworkers receive their regular salary, plus the stipend.

Qualifications:

- Be an employee of Los Angeles County
- Be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be a registered voter in California (only if U.S. Citizen)
- Have supervisor approval

We highly encourage Pollworkers to serve in areas that are difficult to recruit (listed on application).

What hours will I serve on Election Day?

Pollworkers serve the entire day; arriving at 6:00 a.m. and generally finishing at 9:30 p.m.

- Set-up: 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- Breakdown/return supplies: 8:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.
- Voting hours: 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
