## APPROVE 2002-03 APPROPRIATION ADJUSTMENT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF REGISTRAR-RECORDER/COUNTY CLERK (ALL DISTRICTS) (4 VOTES)

## IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

Approve the attached appropriation adjustment appropriating \$1,016,000 in overrealized recording fee revenue to offset early repayment of a Productivity Investment Fund loan.

## PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Due to the uncertain budgetary outcome of next fiscal year, we are requesting an increase to Operating Transfers Out to fund an early repayment of a \$1,000,000 Productivity Investment Fund Ioan plus accrued interest of \$16,000. This Ioan was approved by the Quality and Productivity Commission on February 25, 2002 to fund costs for the Election Tally System/Automatic Ballot Layout Project and was originally scheduled to be repaid over the next four fiscal years. The revised repayment schedule has been discussed with and approved by Quality and Productivity Commission staff.

Based on recording fee revenue collected through May 2003, a surplus in our recording fee budget exceeds the appropriation adjustment request of \$1,016,000.

### Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals:

This request supports the County's Strategic Plan as follows:

**Goal No. 4: Fiscal Responsibility:** Strengthen the County's fiscal capacity. Manage effectively the resources we have by realigning appropriation and estimated revenues to more appropriately reflect our current fiscal environment. Additionally, the Department will realize a saving of \$109,000 in interest as a result of early repayment.

## FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The requested appropriation adjustment is fully funded by increased recording fee revenues resulting from continuing increases in refinancing activity in the real estate market due to low interest rates. This requested action will not increase net County cost.

## **IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)**

The requested appropriation adjustment does not impact current election and recorder/County clerk operations.
