<b>MAR. 22 (F)</b> E – 88	<b>ADOPT SPECIAL MEASURE ELECTION RESOLUTION</b> Last day for governing boards to adopt a resolution calling a special election to place a measure on the ballot. Copies shall be filed with the county elections official. <b>(E. C. § 9401, 9603 and Govt. Code § 61008 (d) )</b>
<b>MAR. 27 (W)</b> E – 83	<b>AMENDMENT OR WITHDRAWAL OF MEASURE – DEADLINE</b> Last day for county elections official to receive a resolution from a legislative body requesting to withdraw or amend a measure previously submitted for placement on the ballot. <b>(E. C. § 9605)</b> <b>MEASURE LETTER DESIGNATION</b> Last day for a district to request a specific letter designation in writing for a measure appearing on the ballot.
<b>APR. 1 (M)</b> E – 78	<b>IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS – LAST DAY TO SUBMIT</b> Recommended last day for County Counsel to transmit impartial analysis of any measure. <b>(E. C. § 9500)</b>

<b>APR. 3 (W)</b> E – 76	<b>APR. 12 (F)</b> E – 67	<b>PUBLIC EXAMINATION FOR BALLOT MEASURE MATERIALS</b> During this period the elections official shall make available for public examination a copy of any ballot enclosures such as, a measure text or impartial analysis. A fee may be charged to any person obtaining a copy of the materials. During this period any person may file a writ of mandate or an injunction to require any or all of the material to be amended or deleted. <b>(E. C. § 9509)</b>
<b>MAY 20 (M)</b> E – 29	<b>JUN. 8 (Sa)</b> E – 10	<b>OFFICIAL SAMPLE BALLOT AND VOTE BY MAIL INSTRUCTIONS BOOKLET MAILING</b> Between these dates the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk shall mail the Official Sample Ballot and Vote By Mail Instructions Booklet to voters. <b>(E. C. § 4101)</b>
<b>JUN. 3 (M)</b> E – 15		<b>REGISTRATION CLOSES</b> Last day to transfer or register to vote in the election. <b>(E. C. §§ 2102 (a) and 2107)</b>
<b>JUN. 4 (Tu)</b> E – 14	<b>JUN. 18 (Tu)</b> 8:00 P.M. ELECTION DAY	<b>NEW CITIZEN REGISTRATION/VOTING</b> A new citizen is eligible to register and vote at the office of, or at another location designated by, the county elections official at any time beginning on the <b>14th</b> day before an election and ending at the close of polls on the election day following the date on which that person became a citizen. <b>(E. C. § 3500)</b>
<b>JUN. 8 (Sa)</b> E – 10		<b>CENTRAL TALLY LOCATION – PUBLICATION</b> On or before this date a notice specifying the public place to be used as the central tally location for counting the ballots shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the jurisdiction. <b>(E. C. § 12109 and Govt. § 6061)</b>

\*\* June 10 (Saturday) and June 11 (Sunday) office will be closed.

DATES	EVENTS
<b>JUN. 11 (Tu)</b> E – 7	<b>CANVASS BALLOTS</b> The canvass may commence on the 7 <sup>th</sup> day before the election but the results of the tally shall not be released until election night. <b>(E. C. § 15101 (b))</b>
<b>JUN. 14 (F)</b> E – 4	<b>REQUEST FOR A DUPLICATE BALLOT</b> Last day the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk will send a duplicate/replacement ballot <b>in the mail</b> .  <b>NOTE:</b> Voters can pick up (and return) a duplicate/replacement ballot <b>in person</b> up to election day at the Norwalk office of the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.
<b>JUN. 18 (Tu)</b> <b>8:00 P.M.</b> ELECTION DAY	<b>ELECTION DAY – OFFICIAL VOTED BALLOTS RETURNED</b> Last day for ballots to be received (by mail or in person) by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk. <b>(E. C. § 4103)</b>
<b>JUN. 20 (Th)</b> E + 2	<b>CANVASS OF ELECTION RETURNS</b> The canvass of election returns shall commence no later than the first Thursday following the election. <b>(E. C. § 15301)</b>
<b>JUN. 21 (F)</b> E + 3	<b>COMPLETION OF OFFICIAL CANVASS</b> The Official Canvass of returns shall be completed within 28 days of the election. <b>(E. C. § 15372)</b>  <b>NOTE:</b> On <b>Friday, June 21, 2013 (E+3)</b> the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is tentatively scheduled to certify the election results. On <b>Tuesday, June 25, 2013 (E+7)</b> the Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election results official. <b>(E. C. § 15400)</b>
