Fifth Ballot Counting Update for the June 7th Presidential Primary

LOS ANGELES - Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the fifth counting update for the June 7th Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **47,446** ballots processed since election night consisting of **473** Vote by Mail ballots and **46,973** precinct ballots. The total election results count is now at **1,889,065** which is **39.3%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated outstanding unprocessed ballots are:

The estimated outstanding provisional ballot count from Tuesday's (6/21) news release was underreported, and did not incorporate the unprocessed miscellaneous ballots.

Election results are subject to change throughout the [Official Election Canvass](#) period. During the official canvass, all outstanding ballots will be reviewed, verified and tallied. The next canvass update will be released on Monday, June 27th.

On July 1st, the RR/CC is scheduled to certify the election results. On July 5th, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to declare the election results official.
