



# IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT POLLWORKER STIPEND INCREASE

Thank you for volunteering to serve as a Pollworker for the November 8, 2016 General Election. In recognition of your dedication and service to the voters of Los Angeles County, we have increased the election worker stipend effective for the November 8, 2016 General Election. This applies to Inspectors, Clerks and NVC Directors. For a description of each stipend, see below:

## INSPECTORS

Inspectors are responsible for the overall operation of a Polling Place on Election Day.

Inspectors can now receive a stipend of **up to \$240**. In order to receive a full stipend of \$240, Inspectors must complete all duties listed below:

- \$150 for serving on Election Day - **(an increase of \$50)**
- \$40 for attending a mandatory 2 ½ hour in-person training and completing Inspector online training - **(an increase of \$15)**
- \$50 for picking up polling place supplies and for returning supplies to the Check-in-Center (CIC) on Election Night

## CLERKS

Clerks help with set-up and breakdown of Polling Place and assist voters.

Clerks can now receive a stipend of **up to \$140**. In order to receive a full stipend of \$140, Clerks must complete all duties listed below:

- \$100 for serving on Election Day - **(an increase of \$20)**
- \$40 for attending a 2 hour in-person training - **(an increase of \$15)**

## NVC DIRECTORS

NVC Directors oversee the Neighborhood Voting Center (NVC).

NVC Directors can now receive a stipend of **up to \$140**. In order to receive a full stipend of \$140, NVC Directors must complete all duties listed below:

- \$100 for serving on Election Day
- \$40 for attending a mandatory 1 hour in-person training and completing online training - **(an increase of \$15)**
