

ARE YOU READY TO VOTE?

- Check registration status at LAvote.net or call (800) 815-2666.
- Review your sample ballot. Received at least 15 days before every election.

VOTE AT POLLING PLACE

- Polling Place information is found on the back of your Sample Ballot.
- Your ballot will be issued by poll workers at the polling place.
- Poll workers are available to assist with marking ballot and using voting equipment.
- After marking ballot, a Precinct Ballot Reader will assist by checking for errors.

VOTE BY MAIL (VBM)

- VBM applications are found on the back of your Sample Ballot or at LAvote.net.
- VBM ballots must be requested
 7 days prior to the election.
- Permanent VBM voters do not need to apply for a VBM ballot.

VOTE EARLY

- Registered voters may vote up to 29 days before Election Day during business hours at the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk office at 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, CA 90650 in Room 3002.
- Open on weekends beginning 14 days before Election Day.
