First Election Results Update for the Statewide Direct Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Statewide Direct Primary Election.

The update includes **83,267** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **1,035,900**, which is **20.15%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted:

- **Provisional ballots:** 139,050
- **Vote by Mail ballots*:** 296,380
- **Misc. ballots**:** 3,970

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the [Official Election Canvass](#) period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
