County Seeking to Pre-Qualify Vendors for future Voting System

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced that Los Angeles County released phase one of the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the County's Voting Systems Assessment Project (VSAP). The first phase of the RFP is intended to pre-qualify interested vendors who like to participate in the upcoming solicitation for the County's new voting system.

In April, the RR/CC received informative responses when it released a Request for Information (RFI) to gauge the interest of the marketplace.

"During this phase we are seeking to identify and pre-qualify vendors who are committed to bidding to help us make the voting system of the future a reality," said Logan.

Logan added that interested parties who want to submit proposals in phase two of the RFP must submit their qualifications in phase one. In phase two, those vendors who get pre-qualified will have the opportunity to present proposals in response to the County's solicitation for new voting equipment and services.

The VSAP is an innovative project launched by Los Angeles County to develop a completely new voting experience for Los Angeles County voters; an experience that focuses on the needs and preferences of the voters themselves – and, that is publicly owned and operated. The proposed new voting experience was designed using a human-centered approach that engaged voters in the design process. To date, the County has engaged over 3,700 voters in the project.

Respondents to the RFP have until **October 16, 2017** to reply. Companies, firms or individuals interested in responding to or desiring more information on the RFP are advised to visit the VSAP website at <http://vsap.lavote.net/request-for-proposals/>.
