Semi-Final Results Announced for the Presidential General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced semi-official results for the Presidential General Election.

A total of **3,186,572** ballots were processed and counted, with **55.81%** of eligible registered voters casting ballots.

After Election Day there are still many outstanding ballots to be counted. During our Official Election Canvass, all Conditional Voter Registration ballots, Provisional ballots and Vote by Mail ballots received on Election Day are processed. Once the ballots are verified they will be counted.

Our first ballot counting update is scheduled for Wednesday, November 4.
