March 12, 2013 Senate District 32 Special Primary Election Semi Final Results Reported

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced the Semi Final Results for the Senate District 32 Special Primary Election on March 12, 2013.

As of 10 p.m. on March 12, 5,130 ballots were counted. It is important to note we share this election with San Bernardino County, the District's entire election results can be viewed [here](#).

The Official Election Canvass period begins on Wednesday, March 13 and ends on Friday, March 15. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a 1% Manual Audit.

On Friday, March 15, the RR/CC is scheduled to certify the election results. On Monday, March 25, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the results for the California Secretary of State. There are no further updates scheduled at this time.
