OFF-LEASH DOG BEACHES IN LOS ANGELES COUNTY

- The purpose of this proposed measure is to increase the number of beaches which allow unleashed dogs.
- This measure would designate between three to five beach areas which allow dogs off-leash. Each beach area shall not be narrower than 1/4 mile wide, nor further than a 10-mile drive from the closest beach which allows dogs off-leash.
- This measure would provide that each dog owner/guardian will pick up after their dogs, respect other beach goers, and abide by common dog park rules, including leashing their dogs between the parking lot and the beach, if necessary.
- This measure asserts that it is cost neutral or revenue generating. The increased parking revenue at these beach areas may more than offset the cost of doggie bags and occasional maintenance.
